



## Grant procedure “New Skills”

**Grant amount:** up to BGN 391,166 (“de minimis” state aid regime), which can be up to 70% of the eligible project costs.

**Who can apply:** Enterprises of all categories.

### Eligible project activities:

- Provision of training for **acquiring or increasing the professional qualification / but not higher than the third qualification degree** / to persons from the target groups, according to the individual characteristics of the person and the specifics of the workplace.
- Workplace support **through a mentor for reassigned employees to other positions at the same employer, with a maximum period of up to 6 months.**
- Specific trainings related to the workplace, **aiming acquisition of specific digital skills, "soft" skills, training for management personnel to upgrade business skills**, trainings connected with circular economy and green transition, introduction of low-carbon, resource-efficient and waste-free processes and technologies, etc.

**Eligible expenses:** up to BGN 2,500 for one person involved in a specific training/ s.

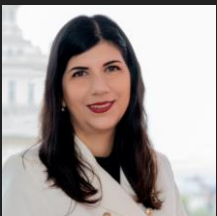
